Note: spoke with Bill on Thursday, December 15, 2011 regarding landowners who have been inadvertently left off the mailing list for the proposed Alma-La Crosse 345 kilovolt transmission line project. He stated that document Reference #156913 was mailed to approximately 100 landowners on December 9th, this is a subset of the original list and was not merged into the mailing properly-that is why the landowners were not notified. Document 156913 gives landowners an additional 30 days to comment, due date now January 23rd, 2012. (as of today (December 17th, 2011) landowners that I have spoken to have not yet received this letter). **If you have not yet received this document immediately call William Fannucchi at the above number and voice your concern!**

- e. June 2012 is when the final decision is scheduled.*
